President's Report

January State Leadership Assembly Debrief

D. Bowling summarized the major actions at the State Leg. Action meeting in January - including a discussion about the term length/limits for region/charter board positions. The State Board is encouraging regions to consider lengthening the terms of key positions such as president and past president to two years. This was a recommendation; however, the State Board emphasized that regions should maintain their own length of service requirements for each board position with one exception: VP of Leg. Action at the region level - The board recommended a three year term for the individuals who hold this position. This is due to the complexity of the leg. action position and depth of knowledge needed to be successful in this position.

Members for Incoming Treasurer and Directors

The Tulare Charter is responsible for filling region treasurer position in 2017-2018.

East Kern will have a director vacancy. West Kern will have a director vacancy. R. Morosa stated that Mark Luque (BCSD) had agreed to fill the vacancy.

Travel Reimbursement Draft (Updates Current Reimbursement Plan to Reflect Needs of Inyo/Mono) Travel needs for members of the Inyo/Mono Charter are unique. David Bowling proposed a 2,000.00 set aside in the Region budget to provide hotel/meal/mileage reimbursement for Inyo/Mono members who attend region meetings. Jose Morales asked for further clarification about how the set aside will be used. T. Addington stated that it would be used to encourage members from the Inyo/Mono Charter to attend region meetings (will only be used for charter members who choose on their own to attend a region meeting). D. Bowling also emphasized that the Region's goal is to encourage greater attendance by Inyo/Mono Charter members. D. Bowling asked members to approve his request.

State Directors' Report

ACSA Financial Standing

A mid year adjustment of 300,000 to 400,000 dollars had to be made at the state level. Funding from professional development seminars and other ACSA statewide activities has not matched what was budgeted. Two state ACSA employees were laid off in response to the shortfall. Meetings have also been scaled back. Also, the ACSA State Board recommended that a COO be hired to assist Wes Smith due to the strain on Wes' health from holding multiple responsibilities. Revision of ACSA's Mission & Vision Statement

This is an ongoing process. Minor changes will likely be made at the next State Leadership Assembly.

Executive Director Evaluation Timeline

Wes Smith will be evaluated by the State Board by the end of the 2016/2017 school year. Leadership Development Committee Update (Also discussed at Leadership Assembly)

Tom Armelino has agreed to accept a part-time staff role with State ACSA to lead this committee. ACSA members also have the opportunity to receive education equity certification through ACSA's partnership with NASS (National Association of School Superintendents).

Other Information from Craig

- * The State Board is working on more alignment between State ACSA and regions (in terms of bylaws, number of leadership positions, what board positions should have votes, etc.)
- * We need to find ways to bring charter schools to the table/find ways to involve them in discussions. Charter schools are educating a significant portion of school age children. Including charter school administrators in meetings, discussions, etc., will serve to strengthen the education system as a whole.
