Over 100 administrators participated on Zoom to develop a deeper understanding of Equity and how it relates to intersectional trauma. This was particularly useful as many administrators were preparing for a return of Hybrid model and listening to families, staff, and students was part of the daily routine. #### In Rememberance of Dr. Gary S. Olsen

A long time Vista resident, community leader, educator, and avid pilot, Dr. Gary Scott Olson passed away at home on May 11, 2021.

Dr. Olson was born in Minnesota on September 18, 1928. Her graduated from Bemidji State University in Minnesota, and later on her became the Senior High School Principal and Superintendent of Schools at Barrett Public Schools and Blackduck Public Schools. Dr. Olson was a veteran who served in the U.S. Army as an instructor at Fort Rucker, Alabama.

Dr. Olson moved with his family to Vista, Ca in 1964. He contributed immensely to the community as a teacher and Principal at Vista High School, and later as Director of Personnel, Assistant Superintendent and Superintendent of Vista Unified School District. He also served on the Board of Directors for the Boys and Girls Club, North County United Way, and Vista Chambers of Commerce.

Later on, Dr. Olson worked as Director of Graduate Education at Point Loma Nazarene University and Executive Director for the Association of California School Administrators (ACSA), Region 18. He also served as State's President of ACSA. Gary was a highly regarded and much loved School Administrator Superintendent in ACSA Region 18. Among other achievements, Gary was Region 18 President from 1979 to 1980, ACSA State President, 1984 to 1985, and Region 18 Consultant from 1992 to 1999. Throughout his leadership roles, Dr. Gary Olson always led with heart and passion for education and his community.

Gary loved traveling with his wife, Carol Souviney Olson (decd. in 2018). They were both incredibly generous with their time, energy, and experience. He loved music, sports, reading, and flying his Cessna 180, but most of all he loved his family. Gary will be dearly missed by his children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and all the people who respected and loved him.
