Associate membership is available to:

- Individuals who meet credential requirements for membership, but who are not currently employed in an administrative or supervisory position
- Administrators who are reassigned to the classroom or other duties outside of administration
- Educational consultants
- Professors of education (may opt for Associate or Regular Membership
- California Dept. of Education (CDE) or Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) employees (may opt for Associate or Regular Membership)
- Individuals who are employed part-time under an early retirement program
- Former ACSA members not qualifying under other membership categories
