Student membership is available to:

• Individuals currently enrolled in an educational administration credentialing program, who are not employed in positions designated as management or supervisory.

Student members receive:

- Weekly updates on administrative job openings through the online Career Center.
- <u>EdCal</u>, ACSA's weekly newspaper, which includes educational best practices, position papers, legislation/policy updates, information on upcoming events, and the ACSA JobLink, a listing of education job openings throughout California and the nation.
- <u>Leadership Magazine</u>, 5 issues a year of the association's professional magazine, featuring research based articles by practicing administrators and educational experts.
- Member rates to attend ACSA's Professional Development programs, offered in small and large group settings throughout the year and may qualify for scholarships to attend. Students have access to a variety of webinars on current and changing topics of interest.
- ACSA member benefits, including **FREE** \$10,000 Accidental Death & Dismemberment coverage, home and auto insurance plans.
- Regular email alerts to keep you updated on legislation affecting your profession.
- Networking opportunities where you can connect with other student members and seasoned administrators across the state
- **PLUS**, if you are employed with a school district you are also entitled to professional liability benefits with an aggregate limit of \$3 Million;

Limitations:

Student members may not vote or hold Association office, nor are they eligible for Professional Legal Assistance.

Qualifying members may remain in the Student category a maximum of four years. Beyond that, a change in membership type and dues will result.
