ACSA REGION 2 INFORMATION
Factual & Statistical Information
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> State ACSA has over 18,000 members, 19 regions, and is the largest organization for school leaders in the nation. Region 2 represents 11 counties - Alpine, Butte, Colusa, El Dorado, Glenn, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sierra, Sutter, & Yuba. Region 2 represents 91 school districts, 186,852 K-12 students, 1.1 million people, and covers 13,762 square miles. Region 2 would be the 42 largest state in size, and 43 largest by total population. There are six active charters in Region 2 - Butte/Glenn, CSY, El Dorado/Alpine, Nevada, Placer, Plumas/Sierra and Retired Leaders & Managers. Region 2 as of June 30 has 765 regular members, and 109 retired members (largest retiree charter in the state.) Regular Membership by County - Butte/Glenn (106), CSY(148), El Dorado/Alpine(161), Nevada(56), Placer(265), Plumas/Sierra(26). At least three Region 2 members have been State ACSA President - Bud Goins, Bill Noble, and Bob Noyes. Region 2 has five delegate votes, one council president vote & one board member vote in the State Assembly (131 votes).
Practical Information - Region Members
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mileage for Region 2 meetings (except DA #3 in So. Lake Tahoe and Gala) are paid to all attendees at State ACSA Rate. (See Reimbursement Form) Region 2 pays for one night accommodation for attending State Leg Action day if traveling over 100 miles roundtrip. All other reimbursement requests to the Region must have receipts and prior approval. (See Reimbursement Form)
Practical Information - Charter Officers
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Charters receive three, one-thousand dollar payments as rebates from Region 2 for a total of \$3,000. Charter rebates are given out at LA#1, LA#2, and at the Leadership Conference. (See Charter Rebate Form) Charters are expected to send three members to attend all Region Leadership Assembly meetings.
Practical Information - Council/Committee Members
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Council and Committee region chairs receive travel reimbursement for state meetings from their council/committee. Region 2 has a budget for Council/Charter gifts and sponsorships which can be approved by the Board. If unable to attend a state Council/Charter meeting, contact the region to find an alternate. Minutes & information from the state council/charter meetings should be forwarded to the Region & Charter Reps.
