	Legislation says figure out how to braid all the funding sources available together, this will be part of the narrative of this application.
	It does not have to be new programming, cannot supplant But Strengthen, Enhance, Expand are allowed.
	How will the fingerprinting law affect WBL that will be part of this grant. There is currently a fix being looked at. Fingerprinting may stay in place for 1:1 situations. This is being worked on and there is no solid solution at this point.
	Legislation asks for students to earn 12 post secondary credits. (CCAP, AP, or IB tests)
	Where does Articulation fit into this process? CCAP is problematic because of ADA Funding.
	What is different about GSP vs. current funding sources: Focus on College and Career Components. Heavy emphasis on aligning on evidence based practices. (Focus on Quality) 5 year Grant (time-limited funding) Used as a start up or launch fund.
