The groups will meet from 5:00 - 7:00 pm on each of the following dates:


- November 7 (in person)

- April 1 (in person)


We are still finalizing locations of the in person sessions. Our plan is to locate them in sites that will be easily accessible to our region's members. Refreshments will be provided.
