

Senator Laird's office has contacted ACSA to gain insight on a legislative proposal for the upcoming year. The proposal aims to give teachers and non-teaching staff priority enrollment for their children in their work schools, even if they live outside the district. It also suggests allowing districts to consider the benefits of continuity in education when making enrollment decisions, helping prevent disruptions for students already established in a school.
