

Bob Blackburn Student Scholarships

The Bob Blackburn Student Scholarships award \$2000 to at least 5 eligible students in Alameda and Contra Costa Counties. Students whose parent or guardian is an ACSA Region 6 member and are graduating high school seniors are eligible to apply.

Frank Wells Memorial Scholarship

The Frank Wells Memorial Scholarship was established in honor of the late Dr. Frank Wells who was an active R6 leader and Superintendent of Albany USD. This \$2000 scholarship is awarded to an African American student graduating from a Region 6 high school and planning to attend a college, university, or community college. (No requirement for parent membership in ACSA)
