		 the Golden State Teacher Grant Program which awards \$20K grants to candidates their credential. Teacher would have to commit to working in a priority school for 4 years and has 8 years to complete service. <u>Question:</u> What is the cost for CTE teachers pursuing their clear credential when they already receive their preliminary immediately with the industry hours? Isn't the cost lower than a teacher who is pursuing their preliminary initially? <u>AB 1929 (McKinnor)</u> - Bill would require that CTEIG data reported to CDE would be disaggregated by race. <u>Question:</u> Any issue/considerations with this? <u>AB 2273 (Holden)</u> - Would establish the California Pilot Paid Internship Program. The CDE would award grant funds to LEAs to establish or expand existing local public-private internship programs. The bill would appropriate \$12,000,000 from the General Fund for up to 5,000 rising grade 12 pupils per year participating in 8-week internship programs. <u>Question:</u> Thoughts on this idea and is this currently happening with any other existing initiative/program? <u>AB 3131 (McCarty)</u> - Bill would first give priority consideration to applicants in historically redlined communities (as determined by CDE) for CTEIG and K-12 SWP <u>Question:</u> Thoughts on this proposal?
