- ACSA Governmental Relations Update
 - MGEL council members provided updates and highlights from the Legislative Action in Washington DC. This included updates on how recent EO's have impacted the Department of Education.

- California Career Resource Network
 - Shared a new curriculum available to support California middle schools.
