- 1.0 Welcome President Derrick Lawson welcomed the group.
- 2.0 President's Vision Derrick shared his vision for the coming year. He will focus on PACE Promoting, Advocating, Connecting, Emulating, and Promoting the organization.

- 5.0 Leadership Summit Vouchers A motion was made by Alain Guevara, seconded by Kim Hendricks, and approved by all for the region to purchase vouchers for the leadership summit.
