





#### **State Delegate Assembly**


- State Board 28 members total

- Region Delegates 87 total
  - Regions select their delegates; generally the region's executive board members
  - Each region's number of delegates depends on membership number
    - Region 12: 933 members (grew by 62) = 5 votes
    - Region 19: 894 members (grew by 77) = 5 votes






### **Charters**




#### Improve Student Outcomes
