March 18, 2016

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

- The Board discussed the "Every Student Succeeding" award and received nominations from three charters as follows:
 - Monterey Charter nominated Maria de Los Angeles Mendez, a student at Central Coast High School
 - San Benito Charter nominated Enrique Ojeda, a student at Spring Grove School
 - Santa Cruz Charter nominated Alex Palmerin, a student at Watsonville High School
- Shawn Tennenbaum, Human Resources Council Representative, made a motion (Matt Bell, Treasurer, seconded the motion) to select Maria de Los Angeles Mendez from the Monterey Charter as the Region 10 nominee to move forward state ACSA's "Every Student Succeeding" award program. All members present voted in favor to support.
- Treasurer Matt Bell made a motion (Past President Dennis Kurtz seconded) to add a \$500 scholarship to be awarded to the Region 10 "Every Student Succeeds" nominee. (This is in addition to the \$500 scholarship for each region to award a graduating senior.) All voted in favor of this motion.
- Randy Bangs, State ACSA Board of Directors, reported on the ACSA Region 10 Mid State Conference. The event was a huge success. The next summit will be held around the same date (second week in March) and location next year. A special thank you to Marta Puga of the Monterey County Office of Education for coordinating registration.
