He has served on writing commissions for the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics and has authored numerous articles and chapters on school leadership and development for education publications.

Dr. Kanold received the prestigious international Damen Award for outstanding contributions to the leadership field of education from Loyola University Chicago, the Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching, and the Outstanding Administrator Award from the Illinois State Board of Education.


