

## More on Dr. Timothy D. Kanold

"Teaching and Thriving in the P-L-C Life!"

The PLC culture is built upon three working ideals be professional, exceptional learning, and build community with one another. Each is central to learning success for teachers and students. In this presentation, Dr. Kanold explores how a fully formed professional educator develops shared and transparent learning routines within a school and team community. Based on his IPPY Gold Medal Award winning book, HEART! Fully Forming Your Professional Life as a Teacher and Leader (2017), this session focuses on how teachers and leaders honor team covenants and use their talents to magnify the results of their work. Dr. Kanold helps teachers and leaders to cut through the busyness and the noise of our daily work to erase student-learning inequities caused by an isolated work culture. Participants discover if they are givers, takers, or matchers and how that choice effects their engagement at work, and the overall performance of their team. By knowing which style is most successful, they can take a deep look at how helping others drives their success as professionals.

When teachers and leaders commit to the PLC at Work process, they reflect on several key questions:

- 1. Why are we reluctant to share our knowledge?
- 2. Are we open to influence and shared values from our peers?
- 3. Are we able to develop our relational intelligence and work *interdependently* with others?

## Timothy D. Kanold

Timothy D. Kanold, PhD, is an award-winning educator, author, and consultant. He is former director of mathematics and science and served as superintendent of Adlai E. Stevenson High School District 125, a model PLC district in Illinois.

Dr. Kanold is past president of the National Council of Supervisors of Mathematics and coauthor of several best-selling mathematics textbooks. He has served on writing commissions for the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics and has authored numerous articles and chapters on school leadership and development for education publications.

Dr. Kanold received the prestigious international Damen Award for outstanding contributions to the leadership field of education from Loyola University Chicago, the Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching, and the Outstanding Administrator Award from the Illinois State Board of Education.
