Mentoring provides a detached outside perspective of the protégé and site or district context, using challenges and needs as learning opportunities. It is non-judgmental and non-evaluative, with topics determined by the protégé. Services can be provided on- or off-site, in person, via telephone or e-mail as determined by the protégé and mentor.

Mentors must be:

- Current ACSA member
- Willing to contribute three hours per month
- Experienced, knowledgeable educational leader
- Excellent listener, facilitator
- Collaborative, confidential, and trustworthy
- Enthusiastic, responsible, and dependable
