eginald Leon Green is professor of educational leadership at the University of Memphis. Dr. Green has served at the teacher, principal, deputy superintendent. and superintendent levels of K-12 education and has been in higher education for 18 years. Dr. Green distinguished himself by co-authoring with Sergiovanni the seventh edition of the book The Principalship: A Reflective Practice Perspective. He has also authored the fourth edition of Practicing the Art of Leadership: A Problem-Based Approach to Implementing the ISLLC Standards and the first edition

of The Four Dimensions of Principal Leadership: A Foundation for Leading 21st Century Schools. Currently, Dr. Green serves as president of the Faculty Senate at University of Memphis and teaches courses in educational leadership with a focus on instructional leadership, school reform, and models for turning around low performing schools. His research interests include school leadership, team building for effective teaching and learning, superintendent/board relationships, school district restructuring, and the effects of nurturing characteristics on the academic achievement of students.
