Drive 0.26 miles
2. Turn left onto S Pyramid Way.
S Pyramid Way is 0.2 miles past Victorian Plaza Cir
If you reach S Stanford Way you've gone about 0.5 miles too far
Drive 0.07 miles
3. Merge onto I-80 W via the ramp on the left toward Reno.
Drive 1.24 miles
4. Merge onto I-580 S/US-395 S/Martin Luther King Jr Memorial Fwy via EXIT 15 toward Carson City.
Drive 4.64 miles
5. Take the Kietzke Lane/So Virginia St exit, EXIT 63.
Drive 0.17 miles
6. Keep left to take the Kietzke Lane ramp.
Drive 0.47 miles
7. Turn left onto Kietzke Ln/NV-667.
Drive 0.12 miles
8. Take the 1st right onto S McCarran Blvd.
Red Robin is on the corner
Drive 0.98 miles
9. Turn left onto Plumas St.
Plumas St is 0.2 miles past Lakeside Dr
If you reach Greensboro Dr you've gone about 0.5 miles too far
Drive 0.05 miles
