#### State ACSA Election 2021

Have you ever wondered how state ACSA leaders are elected? The State ACSA election is held each year at the May Leadership Assembly. State officers are elected by delegations from each region. The Region 6 delegation includes Jacob Berg (Region 6 President), Mark Neal (President-Elect), Pam VandeKamp (Past President), James Parrish (VP Leg Action), Lorianne Ventura (Delegate at-large) and Parvin Ahmadi (State Board of Directors). Our Region 6 Board of Directors will have an opportunity to give input to the Region delegation before the election on May 13.

This year, Region 6 is so proud to have a Vice President candidate represented on the slate. **Parvin Ahmadi** is one of 3 candidates for ACSA Vice President. There are also 4 candidates for Vice President of Legislative Action. All 7 candidates have produced videos of their candidacy to be shared across the regions and these have been shared with our R6 Board of Directors. In 2018, the ACSA Board of Directors approved an electioneering policy change that assured all candidates for state ACSA office would be given fair and equitable opportunities for exposure in the regions.

Parvin has been a superintendent in our region for 11 years and in Castro Valley USD for the past 6 years. She has represented Region 6 on the Superintendency Council and is currently our representative on the State ACSA Board of Directors. She is a highly respected leader across the state who has been recognized for her numerous contributions. Her devotion to equity and voice for students is unmatched.
