Also included:

- Governor's budget generally mentioned adult education. More details will come in February with trailer bills.
- Adjustments to Continuous Improvement process and upcoming application for 2023-2027 funding.
- Adult education needs to show collaboration with Local Workforce Development.
- AB1232- waiver of tuition for EL classes at junior college. Question arose on how this would affect Adult Ed funds and enrollment.
- Funding requirements will be adjusted for site allowances due to consistent low enrollment.
