a. Council President Report

Attended CCAE Conference. Active with CAEAA. Recently sworn in for ACSA Board for 22-23. We as a team should be participating and presenting at conferences about equity. ACSA Leadership in San Diego. Encourage everyone to attend. Want presentations specific for adult education to showcase Adult Ed and value added.

i.Credentialing issues - Cost sample

Raine introduced. Possible survey for credentialing issues. Consider partnership for CNA with a skilled nursing facility. High need in health care. Characteristics of teachers in learning persistence through powerpoint presentation LINK.

(Group conversations regarding credentialing)

Dr. Zachary: Courses related to health care for EL for IET model. Must have a registered nurse to teach this class. Need ability to work with health care providers and loan out RN to come and teach the coursework. Licensure requirements exceed credential requirements.

Giuliana: South Bay Consortium- Start LEA for adult ed credentialing. Tap into the resources.

\$130 million over 3 years for CAEP funding focused on Healthcare pathways for ELL students. It was in the January budget and remains.

a. Legislative Action Week and bill update

Highlighted the importance of participation in legislation. Links provided. \$62.1 million for COLA increase. Will provide information on contact.

AB1491- Carryover of outdated funds. Will come with amendments. 20% carryover. Hold and Harmless no penalty over 20%.

1351: Apprenticeship program for grants. Develop new or expand apprenticeships 16-24 year olds. Confusion on how this applies to adult education. Seems to exclude Adult Ed connected with LEAs. Similar issue occurred with Strong Workforce.

a. CDE – Dr. Carolyn Zachry

WIOA July 2023 - June 2027 has been approved in CDE. Almost ready to post word document for August 1. See and print and Sept 1 portal will open and input your data for demonstrated effectiveness. It was new in the last cycle. No grant for startup. Require that we have a program going. Increase for libraries for workforce reentry for older adults and veterans. Pandemic has effected data. Instead of last year's data, pick from last 3 years of data. Pick it by section. If you apply for 225, 231, 243, pick your best 2 years worth of data. Cannot prepopulate. You will have to put in what years you are pulling from. This is in response to COVID. CDE which agencies to move forward. November 1 narrative should be complete. Be ready to go and put things in November. Close before December holiday. DON'T WAIT. Narrative sections are very similar to last round. Workforce Board. Collaboration. Diversity, Equity, Inclusion is new! Cannot copy and paste this section.

WIOA reauthorization passed the House. Next step is the Senate. Will likely get stuck there due to lack of bipartisan support, but confident.

Grant award will be looking at high of the last 3 years for each agency. GANS may not be out until august. This will be last year pre and post test matching data as a service due to COVID. Employment and earnings outcomes will continue to be a payment point. Include some other outcomes. Transition to post secondary ed and credential attainment. Maybe some changes to the survey for employment and earnings. Collect SSN if you can.

Bottom quartile in employment outcomes nationally. 4th quarter data is lower than 2nd quarter data. Maybe harder for students to return the survey afterwards. Frontload the students with the information that they will receive this survey 2 times per year. Top quartile for earnings possibly due to high minimum wage.

CAEP more additional COLA. Additional funding for LCFF which could become a bargaining issue. How do you fund that type of an increase?

Additional monies for English learners especially those coming to the country with degrees from another country. Health care funding CAEP. LEAs and Community Colleges. Do not have anything available yet.

Launchboard/TE is out. Community college date is inflated. Those entities are compared.

Summer Institute, sign up. California Consortia Meeting: June 15 ABE levels 4-6, Increase student outcomes. Employment and Earnings. Situated in regions. Teams. Shark Tank activities.
