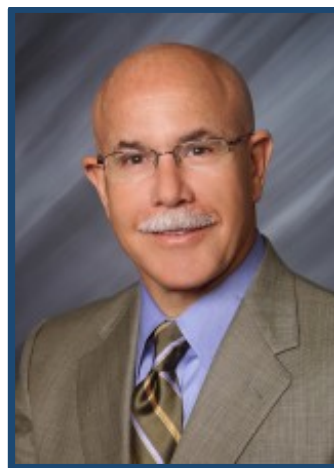


Examining the Changing Demographics in California What do these changes mean for Latino students and their families? Region 8 Forum
